Important Information Regarding a Microsoft Hoax

There is a hoax going around the internet regarding a security vulnerability in IIS 6. A "zero-day" "IIS 6 Remote Buffer Overflow Exploit" was reported. Initial review by Microsoft Product Support Services (PSS) and the Microsoft Security Response Center (MSRC) confirms that this is a hoax to entice people to send their Unix password files to the Full-Disclosure mailing list. This is a hoax – it is not, as the title suggests, an exploit of IIS 6.

PCAOB Proposes Standard on Reporting on the Elimination of a Material Weakness

The Public Company Accounting Oversight Board (PCAOB) proposed for public comment a standard for auditor reporting on an audit client's elimination of a material weakness in internal control over financial reporting (ICFR). The proposed standard establishes a voluntary engagement that would be performed solely at the election of the company. For example, management might elect to ask the auditor to report on the company's remediation of a material weakness, once the remediation process, including the related retesting of the remediated controls, is complete.

The proposed auditing standard (Release No. 2005-002), "Reporting on the Elimination of a Material Weakness", and the related briefing paper are available on the PCAOB website.
